

Ass. Prof. Dr. Vassiliki STATHOKOSTA is a Faculty Member at the Theological School of the University of Athens.

She studied Theology at the University of Thessaloniki; the Ecumenical Institute of Bossey/University of Geneva and the Theological School of Fribourg/Suisse. Her specialty is 'Orthodox Theology and Ecumenical Movement'.

Having an active involvement in the Ecumenical Movement, she is the Scientific Advisor on Ecumenical Affairs of the Greek Orthodox Patriarchate of Alexandria and All Africa. She has been a delegate of the Church of Greece in ecumenical meetings in the frame of the WCC, KEK etc.

She has organized several ecumenical conferences at the University of Athens and she is the academic coordinator for two research programmes in the University of Athens.

She has published studies concerning the women's issue in Orthodoxy and in Ecumenical Movement; issues of proselytism and religious liberty; human rights and freedom of beliefs; issues of Ecclesiology and inter-Christian dialogues.
